100-day report and Police and Crime Plan

Hopefully you've all seen a copy of my 100-day report and Police and Crime Plan. The 100-day report details the progress that my office has delivered against the pledges and priorities set out in the manifesto and I couldn't have done this without collaborative work with partners and colleagues, so once again a huge thank you to all of you. Summer of Fun and Focus

The Summer of Fun and Focus programme was a huge success! We had over 500 young people attend 22 classes across various locations in Bedfordshire and this supports my plans to invest in early intervention programmes to safeguard young people. I want to publicly thank all of our partners that helped to make this happen – Reactive8, Boxing Saves Lives, Ringcraft Boxing and Sendo-Ryu. Due to the success we will be planning more of



these next year and we have two interns working in the office planning these as we speak. More here.

Grant Funding opening for next year

The PCC's Grant Fund for 2022-23 will be open from Monday 6th September and is an annual opportunity for support services to bid into. The fund is split into two key areas — Ministry of Justice fund and Community Safety Fund. The fund will be open for applications until Friday 15th October. Full details on what can be applied for will be available on the website and communicated to partners. The OPCC will be fully transparent with the process and all partners will have sight of each fund and be invited to an open session with the Chief Executive to conclude the biding allocation.

Violence Reduction meetings

Building on the success of our Violence Reduction meetings in Luton, more are being planned for the coming weeks and months across Bedfordshire. We're inviting local residents to a discussion with myself and the Local Authority about serious violence in communities and more importantly, how we can work together to prevent it.
