Drove Road Chapel



Biggleswade Town Council is pleased to announce significant progress in Phase Two of the Drove Road Chapel restoration project.

The French drains have been successfully installed which will help prevent flooding and reduce the risk of long-term water damage.

In addition, low-level repointing works have been successfully completed.

The north and south chapels have also been internally restored and redecorated.

Work is underway to repair parts of the Drove Road Cemetery boundary wall.

The Town Council will provide residents with regular updates via its social media channels and website, ensuring that residents remain informed about the progress, timelines, and any relevant developments relating to the project.

FACILITIES & ONLINE BOOKINGS

The Centre offers a Main Hall and a Training Room, both available for hire.

The Main Hall is approximately 13 x 20 metres, with vinyl flooring and a high ceiling at 5 metres. Its maximum capacity is 120 people, depending on use, making it perfect for classes, meetings, functions, and parties.

The Training Room is approximately 7.5 x 9 metres, with a maximum capacity of 40 people, depending on use. It is available to all organisations and businesses in and around Biggleswade for training purposes and meetings.

Civic Service


17th March 2024
