a. Request for a Defibrillator in Biggleswade

Correspondence has been received from the Biggleswade First Aid Club to ask Town Council to consider purchasing Defribrillator(s), for installation in Biggleswade.

They have supplied quotations and supporting paperwork . A copy is attached to this agenda.

b. <u>Biggleswade Community Agent</u>

At the Town Council meeting of 26 January 2016, Members were asked to consider a proposal from Bedfordshire Rural Communities Charity (BRCC) who were requesting financial support of £10,000 towards the cost of a 1-year pilot to fund a Community Agent for Biggleswade.

It was **RESOLVED** that Town Council have no objection to supporting this project with a contribution of £10,000 for one year. However, they would like to receive reports from BRCC on activities and to review progress after 9 months.

BRCC has appointed a new Community Agent with an expected start date of 1 August 2016. They would like to arrange a meeting with the Community Agent and stakeholders to agree targets and are inviting a representative of the Town Council to take part.

Members are asked to consider selecting a representative to meet with BRCC and the Community Agent to agree targets for the year.
