### a. Lighting Provision on part of unlit Footpath 44- Southern Railway Crossing

Council are requested to consider an email 24/07/2019 from Central Bedfordshire to request further 50% funding of £4000.00 for the cost of trenching work which is likely to be an addition £8k. The total cost would be £13k and the request is for the total of £6500.00 contribution for the trenching work of which £2500.00 contribution was resolved on 14/11/2017.

This matter was previously dealt with at Council Meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2017 and a decision was made as follows:

### A14/11/09.4 d. <u>Lighting Provision on part of unlit Footpath 44– Southern Railway</u> <u>Crossing</u>

An email had been received from Andrew Gillam (ROW Officer – Area 1 (East) regarding the upgrading of the surface along the above footpath, which has now been completed. The CBC Lighting Officer has agreed to a three lamp column extension from the last Brunel Drive lamp column and are now in a position to carry out the works if funding is available. To this end CBC have agreed to part fund the installation and are asking BTC to consider a 50% contribution,

with CBC taking on all future maintenance as the new part is absorbed into the CBC lighting network.

The costing is less than £5K and Members are asked to consider the proposal\_of £2.5K approximately as part contribution.

It was **RESOLVED** to support with proposal with a contribution of up to a maximum of £2,500.

### b. <u>Central Bedfordshire Council and Network Rail – Proposed Closure Lindsell's Level Crossing. Biggleswade Bridleway No. 11</u>

### B23/0703 3. TOWN MAYOR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS.

Cllr Russell gave the following report:

On Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> July, I was invited to speak to Biggleswade Rotary Club about being a Town councillor. I described the structure and responsibilities of the Council to indicate the kinds of issues we have to consider and then spoke about how we can express our views on more strategic issues. I passed the mayoral chain round for them to see and one Rotarian was pleased to find her father-in-law's name on the chain.

I took questions afterwards which revealed interest in town centre regeneration and house building in particular.

On Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July, I spoke again at the Examination in Public of the Local Plan. This was an extra session to discuss the Future Growth Areas in the Plan and CBC's proposal to withdraw Appendix 7, ie. The Grown Areas, from the Plan.

Central Bedfordshire had produced document for the Inspectors to support their request to withdraw Appendix 7. The main argument was that there was the potential for misunderstanding since these were not allocated sites but 'technically through the work done as part of the evidence base to the submitted Plan, these areas were worthy of further assessment and hence would be considered during the Partial Review'.

I argued that the Town Council was not confused by Appendix 7. CBC had identified the Future Growth Areas in some detail in the first iteration of the Plan in July 2017 under the heading of Spatial Strategy Approach and 'seeking to identify and deliver spatial options and strategic opportunities that could provide for longer term economic and housing growth'. A 'provisional capacity' of between 3,000 and 6,600 homes was identified for the east of Biggleswade. I indicated that this approach was helpful in that it could deter unwanted growth in other areas and that it gave a basis for longer term planning for the town.

I acknowledged that detailed planning for the A1 corridor depends on decisions made on national infrastructure but then went on to look at timescales.

East/West Rail – an announcement on the preferred route is expected this autumn. The completion date for delivery is currently proposed as 2027-2028.

A428 Black Cat to Caxton Gibbett, the completion of the Oxford to Cambridge Expressway between the M1 and Cambridge is currently in the first stage of the process to obtain a Development consent Order and construction is anticipated between 2021 and 2025.

Although there is no preferred solution for the A1, it has been identified as a priority by the sub-national transport body for the region, England's Economic Heartland. It is hoped that funding may become available 2025-2030. This means that all three of these hugely important infrastructure schemes are due to be completed within the Local Plan period to 2035 leading to much more demand for housing and economic development sites in East Bedfordshire.

I argued that it is very important for Biggleswade that the Local Plan is in place but also important that Appendix 7 stays since it will help to ensure a faster response to what will be national demands for housing. It is also, of course, why the Government is considering our Housing infrastructure Bid favourably and why the current east Biggleswade site has been given Garden Community status. I also argued for the Partial Review of the Plan to begin within six months to facilitate orderly growth rather than speculative development.

In all, I have spoken on behalf of the Town Council at four sessions of the Examination in Public, which is nearing its conclusion. We now await the Inspectors' report.

Following enquiries, she has established that this is a residential facility for children with special needs and will house three children with spacing for four. Should this application and the previous application be viewed as a whole? Or is it two separate applications? The Planning Department is waiting for information from Highways as there is insufficient space for people to park and they will need round it up or down in terms of staffing. There are a lot of questions that are unclear. The needs of these children are incredibly complex, and the application itself is complex and causing concern to the Planning Officer.

Standing Orders were reinstated.

The Town Council have previously **OBJECTED** to this Application (July 2018) on the grounds of access, and this objection still stands.

We understand that the Application has now come to the DMC with recommendation for approval, which BTC find completely unacceptable. Cllr Bond attended the CBC DMC Meeting and put forward our previous BTC objections, which have not changed and appear to have been ignored. The Town Council position was in the report but was not mentioned or addressed.

BTC is very disappointed with this outcome; it was felt that objections as important as this should have been noted. BTC were not consulted in advance of the DMC Meeting, and as far as we are aware, adequate Fire Safety Regulations have been correctly signed off.

It was **RESOLVED** that a letter of **OBJECTION** be written from BTC to Jason Longhurst, Director of Planning. It was also suggested that a letter be sent from Chairman to Chairman. Whilst writing to the Planning Department we should include reference to the Application for 99 Drove Road, which we understand is a partial application and requires further investigation.

Please see attached map and email below. It looks like this request went to BTC and a 50% contribution was approved based on a cost of £5k – see email from Rob below.

However, Drew did not consider the cost of trenching work which is likely to be an additional £8k. This means a total cost of £13k and a 50% contribution of £6,500.

Clearly this would need to be approved by Biggleswade TC. We will not be able to fund CBC's contribution this financial year as we do not have the money.

Perhaps a way forward would be to wait for the definitive cost from the Clerk of works and at this stage then see if BTC would be prepared to fund 50% of this scheme or not from 20/21 budgets.

An email had been received from Andrew Gwillam (ROW Officer – Area 1 (East) regarding the upgrading of the surface along the above footpath, which has now been completed. The CBC Lighting Officer has agreed to a three lamp column extension from the last Brunel Drive lamp column and are now in a position to carry out the works if funding is available. To this end CBC have agreed to part fund the installation and are asking BTC to consider a 50% contribution, with CBC taking on all future maintenance as the new part is absorbed into the CBC lighting network.

The costing is less than £5K and Members are asked to consider the proposal of £2.5K approximately as part contribution.

It was RESOLVED to support the proposal with a contribution of up to a maximum of £2,500.

Highways Act 1980 - The closure of Lindsell's Level Crossing on the East Coast Main Line, the provision of an alternative bridged crossing and associated improvements to the local public rights of way network

Central Bedfordshire Council has a duty to consult CBC as one of the utility companies (or statutory undertakers) serving the parish of Biggleswade in Central Bedfordshire when proposing to make changes to the highways and public rights of way network.

Central Bedfordshire Council and Network Rail are proposing to close the Lindsell's Level Crossing. Biggleswade Bridleway No. 11 uses this to cross the four tracks of the East Coast main line and exposes walkers, cyclists and equestrians to high speed trains. Network Rail identifies this crossing as a high-risk crossing. We are therefore proposing to replace the level crossing with a new bridleway bridge. We are proposing to site the new bridge approximately 385 metres to the north of the current crossing. This is so that the bridge does not overshadow the nearby solar farm or unduly impinge on the nearby Grade 2\* listed building of Shortmead House. The new bridge will have doubled-back ramps of approximately 185 metres long each side and have a height of approximately 8 metres above the track. The total diversion length, including the ramps, would therefore be approximately 1,200 metres.

Central Bedfordshire Council is also taking this opportunity to improve the local public rights of way network by creating new pedestrian and cycling/equestrian connections as part of the Biggleswade Green Wheel and will extinguish a number of routes that it considers not needed for public use. The proposed changes we are consulting on are shown on the attached plan and described in

the attached schedule. It is possible that you may require use of these public rights of way to reach equipment used as part of your business or for the purpose of maintaining/inspecting your network.

The Council does not know what public rights of way CBC uses for its business. If you do require the use of the aforementioned public rights of way you need to inform us of this requirement - failure to do so could result in the removal of any access rights you may have along this right of way. Any order to create, divert or extinguish a public right of way will not affect any private access agreement or wayleave you may hold with a third party.

We cannot divert or extinguish any public right of way over which you specifically require access without your consent. If you do consent to the creation, diversion or extinguishment of a public right of way we can reserve specific access rights for you - but you will need to tell us what these are so that we can ensure that they remain. You cannot, however, unreasonably withhold consent for the diversion or extinguishment of a public right of way.

It is for these reasons that we ask you to inform us whether you need to use the stated right of way and, if so, what access rights you would require to be retained should you consent to the diversion/extinguishment of these rights of way. If CBC does not require the use of this right of way for access you should tell us so.

I would be most grateful if you would confirm in writing by 31<sup>st</sup> August, if possible, whether CBC's access will be affected by this proposal. I am on leave until the 12<sup>th</sup> August but will respond to any comments or queries you care to make upon my return.

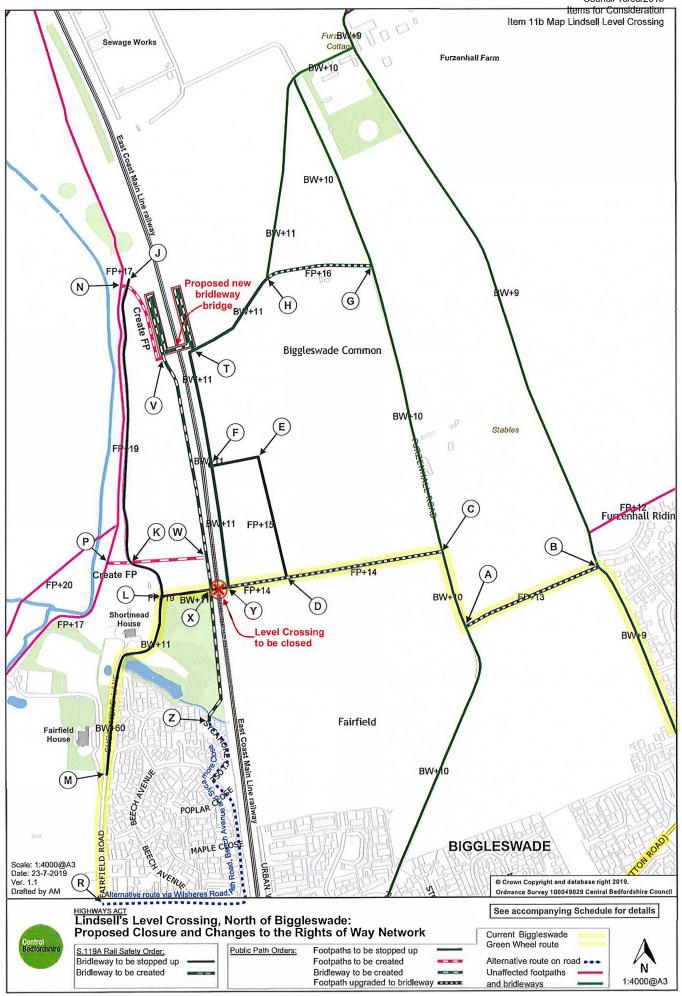

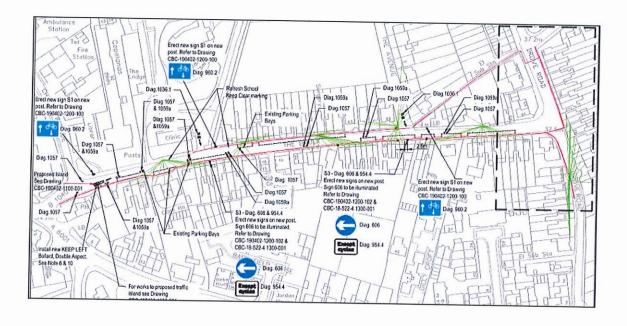

Martin Humberstone has met with Tony Aceto the structural engineer, and are waiting to organise a meeting with Rob when he gets back to go through the ins and outs of the project i.e. the spec etc to move it on to the next stage which is the building regulation application.

All the planning conditions with the planning department have been agreed and dismissed.

Central Bedfordshire Councils Highways department have also agreed the two access points at Drove Road and Glebe Road.

The foul drain from the bowls pavilion, which was listed on the AWA records as a public sewer. This was incorrect and has now been addressed. We had to discuss with the AWA and lain Edmunds the drainage engineer, who visited site and agreed that their records were incorrect. I provided a drawing showing the drain and he would sign it off. This was done. So, the records have been amended and this means that the new drain connection for the facility has been agreed.
