CBC has notified Town Council of an application to carry out work to trees at the above property which is within the Biggleswade Conservation Area.

The proposal is for Hedge Trees 3- 25 conifers and hornbeam – reduce by 40% - located at edge of garden and land to the north.

### b. <u>Safety Cameras in Bedfordshire</u>

Correspondence has been received from CBC to inform Town Council of their proposals and work to date regarding existing safety cameras and the installation of new digital cameras across Central Bedfordshire.

Central Bedfordshire has 36 existing Wet Film safety cameras on its highway network. This stock is old and will need replacing over the next few years. The cost of replacing a wet film camera with a new digital one is circa £35,000 (this assumes that some of the existing infrastructure can be used). The capital budget has been agreed to enable up to 10 of the existing cameras to be replaced in 2014/15.

A further £400,000 has been agreed for the installation of new digital cameras. There is already a commitment for some new cameras that will cost in the region of £150,000, which leaves around £250,000 for new site installations that are to be determined. Where a new site is identified the full cost of the installation will be circa £41,000.

They are seeking to work in partnership with local communities, via Town and Parish Council.

Parishes are encouraged to collaborate and contribute to the cost of installation of camera units in their parishes. The approximate cost of unit is circa £13,000. The cost of a camera is circa £29,000.
