Following the Town Council meeting 13th January 2015, where Council resolved that the Town Clerk write to CBC, the following correspondence had been received;

(Quote) Thank you very much for responding to our Call for Sites process. As we are in the very early stages of this plan we have not yet drafted our site assessment criteria. Once this is done we will be consulting upon it so you will therefore have an opportunity at this stage to input into this particular process. We would indeed be happy to meet and discuss any identified sites with you and what impacts they might have on infrastructure in the town. We would also welcome your continued input once sites have been identified. Please feel free to contact us to arrange a date which is mutually convenient.

With regard to Biggleswade Common, it will not be possible to designate it as an Important Open Space as it does not fall within the Settlement Envelope. I do however believe that you should strongly consider putting it forward for designation as a Local Green Space. Local Green Space must be 'demonstrably special' to the local community and carries a similar strong policy protection as Green Belt. Further information on Local Green Space can be found at paragraphs 76-77 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

You also suggest that Biggleswade Common could be categorised as a Scheduled Monument. This District Council does not designate Scheduled Monuments. If you wish to pursue this route please contact English Heritage. The phone number for the East of England office is 01223 582700
