a. <u>Watercourse Maintenance Programme for 2015/2016</u>

River Ivel Internal Drainage Board Watercourse Maintenance;

Having finalised our maintenance programme for the coming year 2015/16, we have identified watercourses in your Parish where we propose to carry out maintenance works so that they are kept in serviceable condition to manage surface water and help reduce flood risk. We thought that this year it would be beneficial to let you know so that the Parish Council is aware of the Internal Drainage Board's works plan in your area.

The proposed works will be similar to that of previous years consisting of: flailing, clearing, weed cutting, pollarding, and dredging, as necessary. These works will improve flow in the watercourse by removing obstructions and hence reduce flood risk. We will aim to use the same working bank as used in previous years where possible. A formal Notice of Entry letter will be sent to the relevant landowners prior to us starting the work in due course. (plan attached).
