4. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

a. CB/10/01884/FULL – Stratton Upper School, Eagle Farm Road, Biggleswade.

Full: Installation of a double classroom temporary unit for use as an IT suite & general classroom with storage space.

b. CB/10/02169/FULL - 28 Stratton Park Drive, Dunton Lane, Biggleswade.
